Crew Members (Cleaning Dept) responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Arrive on-site on time and ready to work
- Service/clean all guest accommodations on-site, including bathrooms, washing linens and folding laundry
- Keep cleaning facilities tidy and in order, as well as reporting to cleaning supervisor when there is a safety concern / issue
- Maintain the highest level of customer service while communicating with guests on site and at the laundromat
- Use positive, open and appropriate communication with all staff members and management
- Willingness to work early in the morning or late into the evening to prepare/ set-up for large events
- Perform other duties as requested

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma is preferred, but not required
- Candidates must be at least 15 years of age on or before April 1st
- Able to work in a fast paced, outdoor environment
- Must pay strong attention to detail and cleaning routines
- A strong work ethic, positive attitude and willingness to work in a team environment are a must

All crew members must be able to work long hours outdoors in a variety of weather conditions, and must be in good physical shape. Crew Members must be available to work days, weekends and holidays. from **May 27th – Nov. 15th.** (Post Secondary students applying will be required to work until Sept. 6 and then on select weekends from Sept 7- Nov 15th).
